

# New Survey Reveals Percentage of Men And Women Who Would Cheat If Given The Chance

"The results were staggering", said Niall Cronnolly, President of the Atlanta private detective agency. "We reached the maximum number of respondents in just 3 hours!"



The survey participants were asked two simple questions:



The results are as follows:

Number of participants: 4,000

Breakdown of gender participating:

Male		57.1%
Female		42.9%

Percentage answering whether they would or would not cheat:

Yes, I would		50.0%
No, I would not		50.0%

A study conducted in 2002 by the Journal of Couple & Relationship Therapy, revealed that that 45-55% of married women and 50-60% of married men engage in extramarital sex at some time or another during their relationship. The survey conducted by the Atlanta private investigation agency shows that the statistics are still similar 7 years later.
